The data can of course be used for further modelling but unfortunately there is no time or budget to do this with funding from Beacon, or to have results from any such modelling before the final reports from the project.

Juan Carlos Mayor gave a short recapitulation regarding the possibilities for a follow up on Beacon. It turned out it was not possible to apply for EU-funding for a Beacon 2 while Beacon is ongoing, therefore Beacon 2 couldn't be in the second wave of EURAD. Several of the WMO's are in need of the modelling work in Beacon to continue so it is not unlikely that there will be a continuation. In what form is unclear but it will be suggested if there is a third wave of EURAD. All organisations that are interested in a Beacon 2 should express that to their countries representatives in the EURAD colleges. If you need information on who that is contact Mary and I will find the information.

Summarizing the meeting

Patrik Sellin did a short recap of the first day in the morning the 10th, and led a concluding session of the whole meeting, in the afternoon the 10th. The main conclusions were that the teams have done a fantastic job, a lot of interesting results have been produced and big improvements of the models can be seen. But the project and the participants are really suffering from the lack of spontaneous meetings and discussions in smaller groups where these interesting results could be exchanged and fruitful new ideas and continuations could come up. If possible we will have a physical meeting during the autumn, to facilitate such discussions, to prepare for D1.3 and the other conclusive final deliverables, and for the final workshop D1.2. An important purpose of an intermediate meeting during the autumn is also to facilitate for the participants of the project to get as much as possible out of the project towards future work.

The Annual Meeting was followed by a meeting for the EB. There it was decided to organise a day in September with three seminars, one on each assessment case. That day will be 9th September and invitations have been distributed.
